They now understand the needs of the community and how that region functions. This month, they've made a start on selecting the beneficiaries. Can you imagine the excitement of those communities as they have now met with the team to talk about how they can be supported - three years of support and training which will help lift them out of poverty for good!

So far, groups of people have come together to apply to Send a Cow for be part of this project. The team will select those groups which fulfill their criteria - those who have the greatest need in the area.

We know that Caren's group has already been selected which is fabulous news. We will be working with her group, to provide training and skills which will enable them to grow enough food to feed their families, and in the long term, provide them with enough surplus that they will be able to sell what's left and send their children to school. These are exciting times! It's just the beginning of great change. There is so much to do, lots of hard work to come, but with a change of mindset, this community should be able to thrive!
