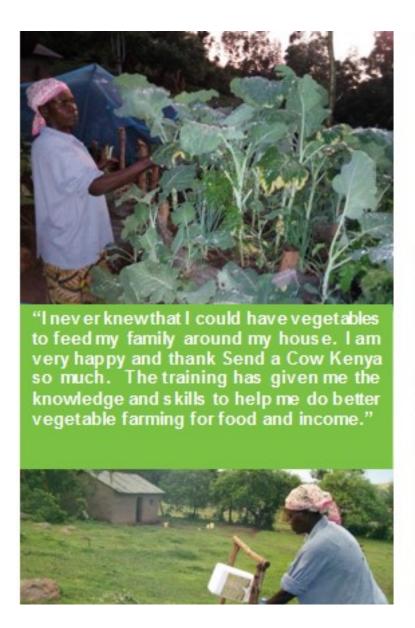


Dear Friends,

Caren is a widow and HIV positive, supporting her family of seven. She is a member of the Ohinga self-help group, which is located near the Kenya Thriving project in Otacho. For years, Caren has struggled to support her family, often only eating one small meal a day. Although she has found the training and creating her garden hard work, her situation has already improved. You can see in the photos Caren picking vegetables to prepare meals for her family from her sack garden and keyhole garden, using the tip-tap and with members of the Ohinga self-help group during training.

This is all great news, however, it's also important to share with you that there is a great need for clean water in this region. We are currently working on a spring capping project which you will hear more about over the coming months. We would really appreciate your prayers as we plan this project to ensure that Caren and her community have access to clean water. As you can imagine, this is a matter of urgency!
